On the *I*st *Sunday of Advent*, the purple candle on the bottom left is lit. It is known as the "Hope or Prophet's candle", because it represents God's promise to Adam & Eve after they lost heaven by disobeying Him, but He promised to send them a Redeemer.

They will inform a Sacristan who will take you & your partner / family to the altar for instruction & practice prior to the start of the mass. The lighting will be done at the beginning and Father will request the lighter(s) of the candle to come forth.
