Advent Wreath &It's Meaning: Dec 17th

This Advent Season, we will again be seeking parishioners to come up and light the week's candle on our Parish Wreath.

On the *3rd* Sunday of Advent, the pink candle on the top right is lit. It is known as the "Joy or Shepard's candle, because it represents the joy felt by Mary & Joseph, because Jesus was in Mary's womb, awaiting His birth, and Shepherds were the first to visit Him. If you are interested in doing this, please tell the Greeter as you enter the Church. They will inform a Sacristan who will take you & your partner/family to the alar or instruction & practice prior to the start of mass. The lightening will be at the beginning and Father will request the lighter(s) of the candle to come forth.
