Bring Your Driver's License

Persons requiring a police check eg.those with keys, deal with children, and vulnerable adults, should bring their license to the meeting, Monday November 27th at 6:30 pm. The police will be here to fill out the forms but if you don't bring your I.D. you will need to travel to the Sydney Police Station.

Important Meeting for All who Serve

Every 5 years all clergy, staff and volunteers are required to have an educational session on Responsible Ministry in the Church, and some in high-risk positions will also require a police check. This meeting is compulsory to educate parishioners in ministry on what misconduct looks like and their duty to report misconduct of minors, but also vulnerable adults. Individuals who serve in various ministries in the Church always have a duty to report:

We have a duty to report misconduct by a bishop, priest, deacon or lay person. Since clergy and laity work with children, and people of all ages, including vulnerable adults, we need to know the boundaries, expectations and protocols.

The meeting for St Joseph Parish in North Sydney is scheduled for Monday, Nov. 27th at 6:30 pm in the Parish Hall below the Church. Most will only need to attend the educational session and sign to abide by the protocols and some like the priests will also require a police check. Peace, Fr. Doug
