Palm Sunday marks Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Crowds of people gathered to shout his praises, and many of them laid palm branches and their cloaks on the road, hailing him as the Messiah. Little did they know that within a week, they would turn against him and demand his crucifixion. As symbols of these related events, we have decorated the steps of the main altar to signify the road leading into Jerusalem, covered with palm branches, and in front of the high altar, we have a symbol of what is yet to come, the wooden cross, marked with palm in its center and draped in red, of the soon-to-be-spilled Holy Blood of Jesus, as recounted in the reading of 'The Passion of the Lord''. During this most Holy Season, remember how Jesus offered so freely of himself, for the benefit and salvation of the human race.

### Bio: Kevin Moynihan (KM Productions.ca).

Kevin Moynihan grew up in Montreal and attended University (Loyola College) in the 1960's earning a BA in Theology. Kevin also earned a Master of Education degree (Adult Education) from The University of Toronto (in 1975).

Since the early 1970's, Kevin has been producing Educational Media for Government (Federal and Provincial); Departments of Health; Hospitals and National Religious Organizations. One project from that decade of which he is very proud is a slide tape documentary in support of the First Nations people of the North West Territories during the MacKenzie Valley Pipeline Debate which was based on the Canadian Bishops' Labour Day Statement entitled "Northern Development: At What Cost?".In the 1980's Kevin produced documentary films for the Dept. of Health in PEI. In the 1990's he produced a series of films for Vision TV on Church Art and Architecture. During that decade he produced distance education programming with Faculty at Atlantic School of Theology which was broadcast on the ASN Network In Atlantic Canada. In 2007, he set up the website KM Productions.ca. All of his films since then are available there including films on issues like Ecology, The Residential Schools Issue in Canada, The Papal Encyclical "Laudato Si" the Principles and Values of the Co-operative System and the Role of Canada's First Responders in welcoming and caring for the Famine Irish In 1847, a film which has become part of the exhibit at the National Famine Centre at Strokestown, Ireland.
